

Yulia Musayelyan is a flutist and composer originally from Moscow, Russia. A versatile performer fluent in classical and jazz idioms, she is the founder of New Music Collective, dedicated to performing new original chamber music. In addition to classical collaborations, Yulia actively performs with Jazz and Latin music projects. A recipient of the 2001 NFAA Award, she was a soloist with the TACTUS Contemporary Ensemble with guest conductor maestro Pierre Boulez in 2005. Her chamber compositions have been premiered at Symphony Space in New York City and featured in the 2006 film *Natalie Bonn*. Yulia has recorded over 20 albums as sideman, and released her quartet's debut album, 'Caminos', in 2009. She leads a quartet, the YM ChamberJazz Trio, and NMCollective, and performs regularly with MOZIK, Fernando Huergo Quintet, MUZAduo, Marta Gomez and Manhattan Camerata, among others. Yulia has toured the US, UK, Europe, Central and South America with various musical projects. In addition to performing, Yulia is an active educator, teaching flute at Lexington Community Education and privately in the Boston area.
